Harvest

The grapes for the 2009 vintage of our Black Series Merlot were harvested on November 9th, 10th and 13th from Niagara-on-the-Lake vineyards.

Winemaking

The 2009 Meritage is a blend of 21% Cabernet Franc, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 59% Merlot, and underwent 100% malolactic fermentation with select yeasts. Through the art of blending and aging the wine for 18 months in French & American oak barrels, the Meritage guarantees a wine of exceptional quality.

Winemaker's Notes

Our Meritage is full-bodied with complex red fruit, pepper, and leather notes on the nose, and hints of plum, cherry, dark chocolate, and spice on the palate. The wine displays a smooth, lingering finish...
