Jackson Triggs Black Series 2009 Merlot VQA Okanagan Valley

Harvest

The grapes for the 2009 vintage of Black Series Merlot were harvested from our Bear Cub, Bull Pine and McIntyre Bluff vineyards on October 3rd, 2009.

Winemaking

This vintage of Merlot was aged in both French and American oak barrels for 12 months, and underwent complete malolactic fermentation to impart rich complexity and structure.

Winemaker's Notes

Our Black Series, formerly Proprietors' Reserve, showcases the depth and diversity of our winemakers' experience in crafting wines that embody the Okanagan terroir. We craft the Black Series wines to promise exceptional quality and value.

The 2009 vintage gave us a Merlot with distinct ripe plum and black cherry notes, and just a hint of chocolate. Velvety smooth, but firm tannins on the palate enhance the silky, lingering finish.

Food Pairings

This wine is perfectly complemented when served with grilled steak, pastas in rich tomato sauce, Beef Wellington, veal in a red wine reduction and medium aged cheeses.
