JACKSON-TRIGGS WINS IWSC 'WORLD'S BEST' DESSERT WINE TROPHY FOR THE SECOND CONSECUTIVE YEAR

Derek Kontkanen, Jackson-Triggs Okanagan Estate Winemaker, has just returned from London, England where he accepted the prestigious 'World's Best' Dessert Wine Trophy at the IWSC Awards Banquet for his 2007 Proprietors' Reserve Riesling Icewine. The 2011 Awards Banquet for the International Wine and Spirits Competition hosts the wine world's finest producers.

Founded in 1969, the *International Wine and Spirits Competition* is recognized as the world's premier competition of its kind. Its aim is to promote the quality and excellence of the world's best wines, spirits and liqueurs.

Jackson-Triggs is no stranger to top awards at IWSC. This 2011 Trophy on its own is a major win for Derek but it is the second year in a row that he has captured this highly sought after award. Derek won the Best Dessert Wine Trophy in 2010 with his Proprietors' Grand Reserve Riesling Icewine 2007 while Winemaker Brooke Blair was awarded the 'World's Best' Merlot Trophy for her 2007 Jackson-Triggs Proprietors' Grand Reserve Merlot. Jackson-Triggs has previously captured IWSC Top Canadian Producer in 2010, 2007.

Derek proudly accepted the Best Dessert Wine Trophy this year from the President of the IWSC Prince Robert of Luxembourg as pictured below.
